

## **A Reminder of Health Requirements!**

All alpacas brought into the fairgrounds facility (show OR companion) will be required to have a Veterinary Certificate of Inspection, completed no more than 30 days prior to the last date of the show (must be dated AFTER April 11, 2008). Documents must include negative BVDV PCR or VI and microchip identification.

In previous years, Oregon resident animals could obtain a Certificate during the veterinary inspection at check-in. Note that in the interest of time, we have DISCONTINUED this option, and it is necessary for you to obtain this Certificate from your own veterinarian, BEFORE you leave home. BVDV testing is REQUIRED, and may take several days for processing! Be sure and allow yourselves plenty of time for appropriate test results. Any animal exhibiting diarrhea, fever, abnormal discharge or evidence of parasites will be excused.
